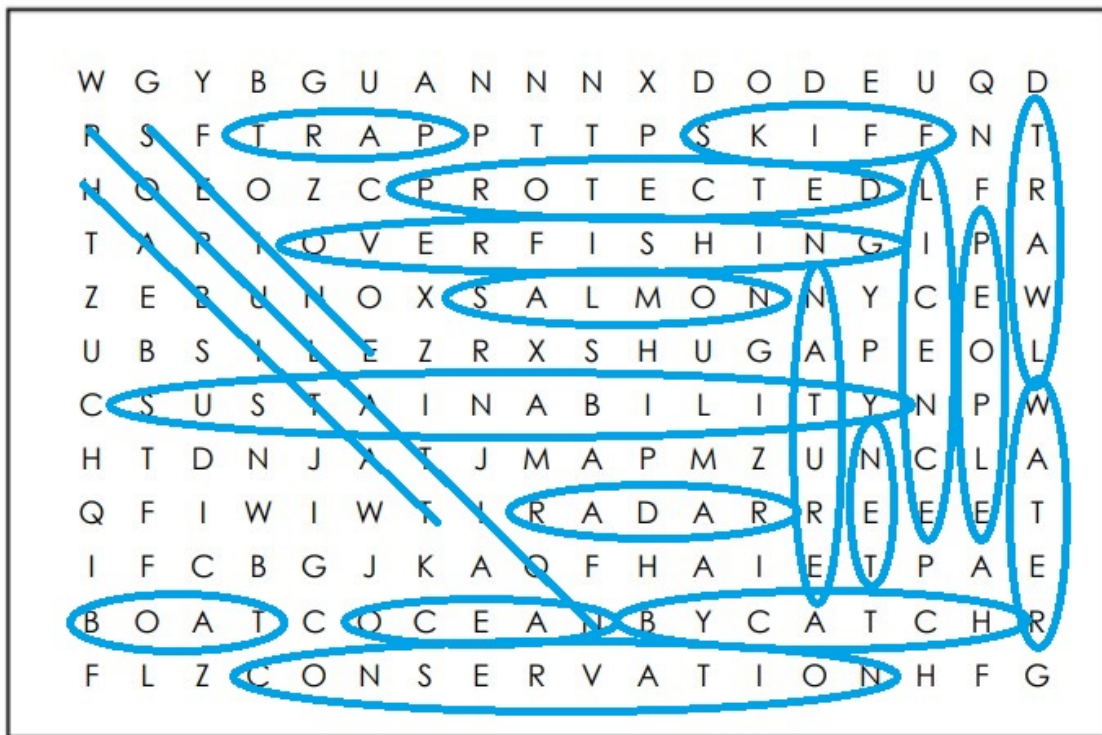

Can you find the fishing words?

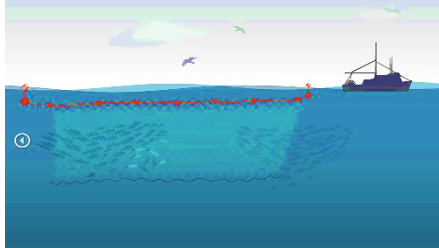

Connect the method of fishing to the correct image:



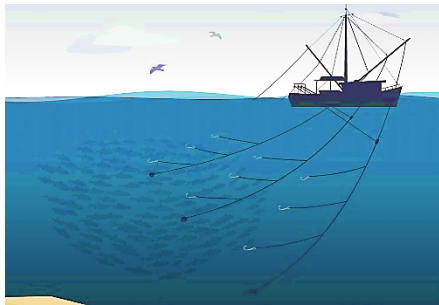
Longline

A heavy and very long fishing line with a large number of baited hooks, used in deep-sea.



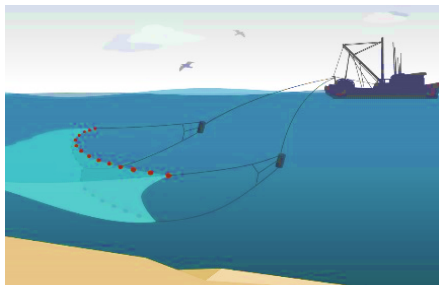
Troll

A method of fishing in which a lure or a bait is pulled behind a boat



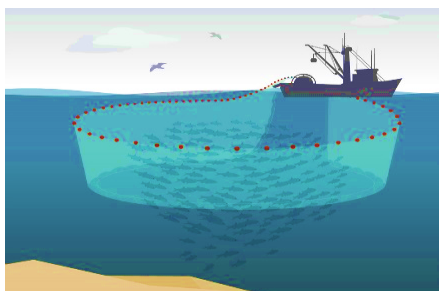
Seine

A vertical net 'curtain' is used to surround the fish, the bottom of which is then drawn together to enclose the fish



Gillnet

is a wall or curtain of netting that hangs in the water.



Trawl

use a cone-like net with a closed end.

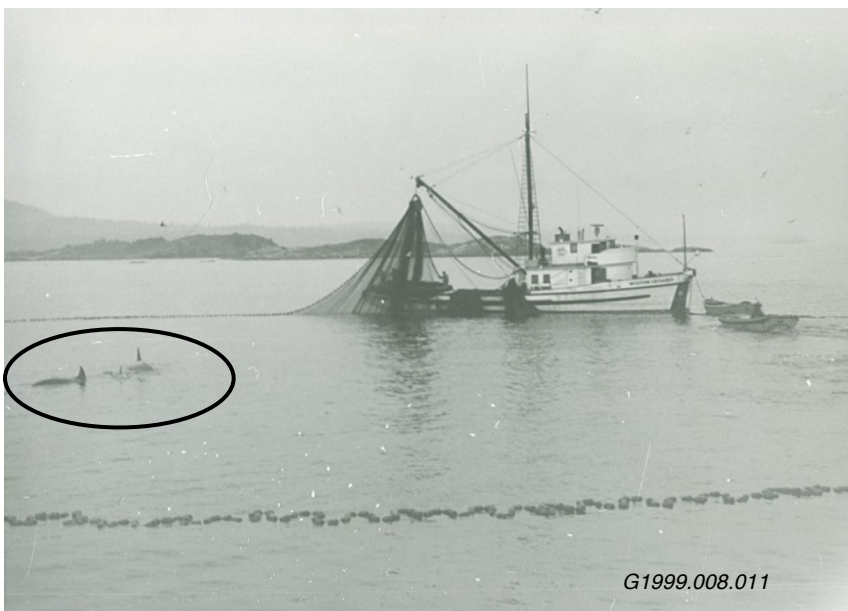
